The sights and sounds of the movies also resonate throughout the three videotapes. Freud influenced the moving pictures and now the movies have influenced the shrinks.

Come On Touch It

Ian Murray 1983

Murray's Come On Touch It offers participation to its audience and then systematically denies it. Sound familiar? This multi-layered tape depicts and reveals the electronic surveillance landscapes so essential to control systems.

Numerology Of Fear

Janine Marchessault, 1998

Marchessault's Numerology Of Fear collages archival stock with docu-dramatizations. The men personifying as well as enforcing psychoanalytic and cinematic narratives

are playfully brought to light and then made public. Within the halls of pop and 'legitimate' psychiatry; women and gay men existed to be either examined as curious specimens or else cured of their threatening afflictions. Cold War paranoia has itself been made possible by narrative film's paradoxical fascination with fear.

A Gun Makes An Awful Mess

Michael Achtman and R.M. Vaughan, 1999.

Achtman and Vaughan's collaboration A Gun Makes An Awful Mess mixes angry performance monologue with black and white Super-8 footage that could easily be re-scanned film noir. Here the patient claims performance space and the doctor is forced into a passive audience position. Is there a doctor in the house? Well, not any longer!




